The Church Compass

The Church accompanies us on our journey through life, through the seasons of the year and within the changing circumstances of our daily lives. The following themes can serve as a guide along this path. They can be used individually, as a family or in groups.

Remember: Was there a time you saw something that really frightened you but also unsettled your mind? Have you ever talked to someone you have not seen in a long time who you did not recognize at first, or seen someone with a familiar face but could not put a name with it?

Read: Luke 24:35-48

Reflect: It often seems more logical to attribute Christ's appearances after his resurrection as visions or that he appeared as some sort of angelic being. Not so. Christ goes to great lengths to demonstrate that he is no ghost or some sort of creature from the dead—that he is as real as he was before his death, even more real.

Review: *From the perspective of the apostles, what was their weakest point?* 1. Their eyesight was poor? 2. They were too emotional? 3. They were not experts on the Scriptures? 4. They failed to believe the truth of Christ's past promises? 5. They needed hard evidence first to work with? 6. They were wracked with guilt and fear?

Respond: *From your own perspective, how would you respond to Christ standing before you?* 1. I would bow down and worship? 2. I would run away? 3. I would think it was a prank. 4. It wouldn't be him if he didn't have long hair and a beard? 5. I would ask him to prove his identity? 6. I would ask for forgiveness of my sins? 7. "It's the end of the world."
