## SUNDAY SCRIPTURE OVERVIEW

### First Reading: Ezekiel 2:2-5

The first reading is of Ezekiel's appointment as prophet among the exiles in Babylon.

### Second Reading: Second Corinthians 12:7-10

St Paul feels forced to prove that he was a true Apostle. That he suffered much for Christ and His Gospel, and had been given the privilege of special visions and revelations. He goes on to describe weaknesses he has which troubled him. He concludes that he is content with weakness and sufferings because the power and strength of Christ, working through a weak instrument, will be all the more visible and convincing.

### Gospel: Mark 6:1-6

What happened in Nazareth was a foretaste of the later reaction of the scribes and Pharisees, the leaders of the people, to Christ's claim to be the promised Messiah. The people of Nazareth tried to do (Lk. 4:29-30), what the religious authorities in Jerusalem succeeded in doing, because they were able to threaten the Roman governor with blackmail. Unknown to themselves, they were putting into action God's plan for mankind. It was necessary that Christ should die so that all men could live forever with God. Christ's death, followed by his resurrection, was the key that opened the door of eternity for the human race.
