SUNDAY SCRIPTURE OVERVIEW

First Reading: Ezekiel 17:22-24.

In this reading the prophet Ezekiel spoke about the better days that were to come for the Chosen People; when Yahweh would take back to His people once more, and dwell in their midst forever. Today's extract is a messianic prophecy in which God says that he will raise up a descendant—a sprig from the lofty cedar David, who will yet be the glory of Israel.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:6-10.

St. Paul tells the Corinthians that his constant desire and motive in life is to please God. In this he wants them to imitate him. While on earth this is his aim and when he goes to God in heaven, this will be his purpose and his delight.

Gospel: St. Mark 4:26-34.

"To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade."
